## Dress Code

The dress code for the Graduation Ceremony is formal. Students who wish to attend a graduation ceremony at a venue are required to wear the prescribed academic regalia

## Registration

Please register at the registration desk upon arrival. The registration desk will be clearly marked and located near the entrance to the venue. You will receive a card with a pre-allocated seat number according to academic programme.

### Academic Regalia

Academic regalia can be collected after registration. Please use your name card to collect the regalia.

### Proceedings

- Please present the seat number card to an usher upon entering the graduation venue. The usher will escort you to your seat.
- The assembly will be requested to stand when the academic procession enters the venue. Please remain standing until the academic procession is seated.
- Graduands and guests will be formally welcomed, followed by a graduation address by a guest speaker.
- Ushers will guide Graduands to the stage. When instructed, Graduands will present their name card to the name reader at the podium.
- When called, Graduands will cross the stage individually and take part in the commencement ceremony. An official stage photographer will capture the moment.
- Graduands will return to their seats when exiting the stage. Doors to the venue will remain closed and Graduands and guests remain seated for the duration of the ceremony.
- Academic awards will be awarded toward the end of the ceremony.
